Crost Paper Cup Wreath

Your guests will have to do a double take when they find out that this whimsical wreath is made from ordinary paper cups! When you stop by Dollar Tree to pick up your party supplies, pick up some extra cups and make this clever paper cup wreath — you know it will coordinate with your décor because you've used the same cups you're serving up your drinks in and have also picked up the matching plates and napkins! How genius and simple is that?

Shop at Dollar Tree – Here's What You'll Need:

- Paper Party Cups, About 24–30
- Glue
- Ribbon

Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

- Open your cup packages. If you are using multiple colors, determine the order you want to put them in and go ahead and stack them that way, with the seams all facing the same direction.
- 2. Put a dollop of glue on the inside top of the first cup so that when it is on it's side, the glue is on the bottom and the seam is to the back. Also put a generous dollop of glue on the bottom outside of the second cup, so that when it is on it's side, the glue is on the top and the seam is to the back.
- 3. Holding the cups sideways, insert second cup into first cup about halfway, seams to the back, at an angle that secures the glue spots.
- 4. Repeat until you can attach the last cup to the first cup in the same manner.
- 5. Use ribbon to add a pretty bow and hang.

Fun Tip:

 Use one color or many — be creative! Use school colors for graduation; all white for a casual wedding; red, white, and blue for a patriotic cookout; Dad's favorite team colors for Father's Day; or even pink and blue for a baby shower!
