Ice Cream Cone Balloons

Whether you scream, I scream, or we all scream, ice cream is THE treat for summer. Now you can bring summer's favorite treat to all your parties with no worries of melting! For just a few dollars you can create these clever balloon decorations that are great for birthdays, cookouts, baby showers... or any fun occasion.

Shop at Dollar Tree – Here's What You'll Need:

- · Round Latex Balloons, Inflated with Helium
- Kraft Paper
- Scissors
- Tape

Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

- Cut large circles out of the kraft paper, each circle will complete 2 ice cream cones (for a 9-inch balloon, we used a compass set to a 9-inch radius.)
- Cut circles in half. Each half circle will make 2 cones.
- 3. Fold half circle in half to make a quarter circle and roll into a cone shape. Tape or glue edges together.
- 4. Feed the balloon's string through the cone, taping the cone to the bottom of the balloon. Be careful to tape down exactly where you want it as removing the tape will most likely pop the balloon.

Fun Tip:

• Don't have helium? Blow up smaller water balloons and tie to the end of a bamboo skewer. Stick the skewer through the paper cone and tape in place. Poke several in a block of covered floral/craft foam for a sweet centerpiece!
