Lavender Door Wreath

Veronica B.'s favorite color is lavender or light amethyst. To showcase her love of purple, Veronica picked up a few items from Dollar Tree and made this Lavender Door Wreath... it's perfect for your front door, over your mantle, or as an added pop of color to your powder room. Shop at Dollar Tree – Here's What You'll Need:

- 1 Wicker Wreath
- Thick Purple Ribbon (or Your Favorite Color)
- 2 White Artificial Rose Bushes
- 1 Pack of Butterfly Craft Embellishments.
- 1 Large Bow
- Decorative Bird and/or Other Embellishment
- Glue or Floral Tape

Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

1. Affix the large bow at the bottom center of the wreath using glue or floral tape.
2. Cut the individual roses off of the rose bushes (leaving about 2" of the stem).
3. Insert, then glue the roses on either side of the large bow.
4. Glue the butterflies around the wreath. Use the butterflies to fill in some of the empty space not already covered by the roses.
5. Take about 20" of the thick purple ribbon, loop it around the top of the wreath, then tie a bow.
6. Hang your wreath (using the purple bow at the top).
