Recipe Witch's Finger Cookies



Need something ghastly and tasty in a jiffy for your Halloween party? Serve up a little *finger food...* severed witch fingers, that is! These spooky delights are just simple sugar cookies made from a mix, topped with packaged pumpkin seeds and a little melted chocolate. We'd give them two thumbs up if we had any!

Shop at Dollar Tree – Here's What You'll Need:

- Sugar Cookie Mix (plus the ingredients needed)
- Pumpkin Seeds (sliced almonds will also work)
- Green Food Coloring
- Chocolate (optional)

Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

- 1. Mix up the sugar cookie dough according to the directions on the box for shaped cookies. Add a few drops of green food coloring until the desired color is reached.
- 2. Roll and shape dough into fingers, press a sliced almond or pumpkin seed into one end as a fingernail, and bake according to package directions.
- 3. Optional: melt a little chocolate and, once the cookies are cool, dip "severed" end in the chocolate to give a dried blood look.
