## Chocolate Caramel Pretzel Bites



Sometimes the simplest things can be so amazing. If you're looking for a quick and easy-to-make sweet treat, then these decadent chocolate caramel pretzel bites are for you! With just a few ingredients and absolutely NO baking know-how necessary, you can make them for all your holiday get togethers, or in large batches to give as gifts to family and friends. Or, maybe just make a few for yourself while you curl up in front of the fire to watch the snow fall... fa-la-la-la-fabulous!

### Shop Dollar Tree, Here's What You'll Need:

- Bite-Size Pretzels
- Rollo® Candy
- Candy-Coated Chocolate Pieces (such as M&Ms®)
- Wax Paper

### Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350°.
2. Place wax paper on a cookie sheet.
3. Lay the pretzels on top of the wax paper in a single layer.
4. Place one Rollo® in the center of each pretzel.
5. Bake for 4 minutes (to soften the candy without melting).

6. Remove from the oven and immediately press one candy-coated chocolate piece in the center of each Rollo®.
7. Allow the chocolate to harden (refrigerate to speed up the process).
