
OVERVIEW





LOGO CLEARANCE ZONE



Clearance Zone

To protect the visual integrity of the logo nothing should appear within the clearance zone.

The clearance zone (X) equals the width of the rounded rectangle, ensuring the logo always appears legibly on a clear background.

The clearance zone should be applied to all NBA Event and League logos.

The NBA reserves the right to request more space than the clearance zone, if, in its opinion, placement appears like a new logo or identity.





Background sections are created by using lines from a basketball. The individual basketball lines can be separated, sized, rotated and placed anywhere to achieve desired layout.


CREATING BACKGROUND SE



Creating Background Sections




STEP 1: Arrange basketball path lines on layout. Each line needs to run off the outer edges of the canvas/layout.



STEP 2: Add a box around the canvas and "Divide" the path lines to create separate sections.

After path lines are divided into separate sections, convert the paths to an "outline stroke".



STEP 3: Assign the outlined strokes a color from the All-Star 2018 Color Pallette.

Purple and yellow must always be on the left and red and blue on the right.



STEP 4: Add an additional white stroke around the outer edge of each outline section. Make sure to align the stroke to the outside.

The width of the white strokes should be **1.5x** the size of the original line.

Example: If original line is 4pt the outer strokes would be 6pt.

Convert all paths to an "outline stroke". See sample art for reference.



STEP 5: Group all the lines together and give the entire structure a drop shadow. All drop shadows should be set at a 135° angle for consistency.

Drop shadow size, distance and opacity varies depending on the program and artwork size. Adjust as needed.

STEP 6: To add colored pattern backgrounds to each section, repeat Step 1 and 2 and use the sections as a clipping mask for each background. Arrange the sub-layers to achieve the look of the primary creative.

Purple and yellow must always be on the left and red and blue on the right.







STEP 7: When placing a logo or text over a color or white section(s), a glow or color fade should be added behind the logo to help separate the logo from the background patterns.

This color fade should match the color of the background directly behind the logo and cannot spill/cross over to the other colors. See Sample art for reference.

The NBA All-Star Primary Logo can not overlap onto the multi color backgrounds. It should remain within the white area.
